Driving Standards

- SA is the only state that does OLT's at a race meeting
- 8-hour flags is no longer compulsory the topic has been brought up with MRP as a suggestion from QLD to reintroduce it
- Penalties are up to the stewards rather than CoC which makes in-race penalties and harsh decisions difficult to administer
- DSO Motion Club is looking into a permanent DSO but noted they are only an advisory source, and their recommendations will not be taken into the decision of a penalty. Club is willing to contribute \$500 per round (max) if they commit to the full season. <u>Motion Moved – NS / Carried</u>
- Looking into MA Grant Funding for education purposes
- Toyota 86 Series style drivers' briefings
- Start of Season Induction / Beginners guide needed
- Members would like to see more in-race penalties CEASA to investigate Further Regulations for this to occur.
