#### 1. Minutes of previous meeting

#### 2. Presidents Report

Supercars event, well done to all who helped make it happen - Nick Skaife, Jake & Lisa Totani, Kristen Bailey, with minimal work for competitors to bump in and run. Thanks to all officials & staff, and competitors who raced hard and fair, with no safety cars, red flags or incidents.

#### 2.1. Motorsport Australia update

Motorsport Australia are restructuring to rationalise costs - including closing the SA office. Paul Falco raised an issue with closure - access to materials and resources such as compulsory Motorsport Australia stickers. Nathan has discussed associated gaps and opportunities with Eugene Arroca, such as improving systems to reduce workload at the track - using digital forms over paper forms etc.

2021 calendar - likely to continue with 5 rounds, but some categories may run at a lesser number of those rounds. Nathan asked attendee's - many happy to run 4 round calendar. Question, Mallala grid density, how will it be handled. Favourable feedback on West circuit from Supercars event, suggestions that calendar use both International circuit one round, West the next.

#### 3. Secretary Report

#### 4. Treasurers report

Wayne reported approximately \$60k in bank, but with \$30k to be outgoing (such as prize winners from recent event), lots of work to be done over coming weeks to balance the account before AGM.

#### 5. CERA Update

Andrew reported that revenue from the Townsville event didn't go back to the CAMS affiliated X3 series, but instead the AASA Track Attack group who was approached to run the event, as opposed to the CEASA run The Bend Supercars event.

CERA have short listed 3x suspension tenderers and 2x tyre tenderers, more info on those to come (currently info under review is commercial in confidence). CERA has published a report on how to communicate issues and enquiries up to CERA from state and club level.

#### 6. Tech Delegate update

Draft Tech Document has been published by CERA - aim to assist engine builders, sealers and scrutineers interpret and enforce technical regulations. More work to be done to reduce grey areas in technical documents.

#### 7. Promotions

Thanked everyone for putting on good show at Supercars, and thanked sponsors (Lawnhub etc).
